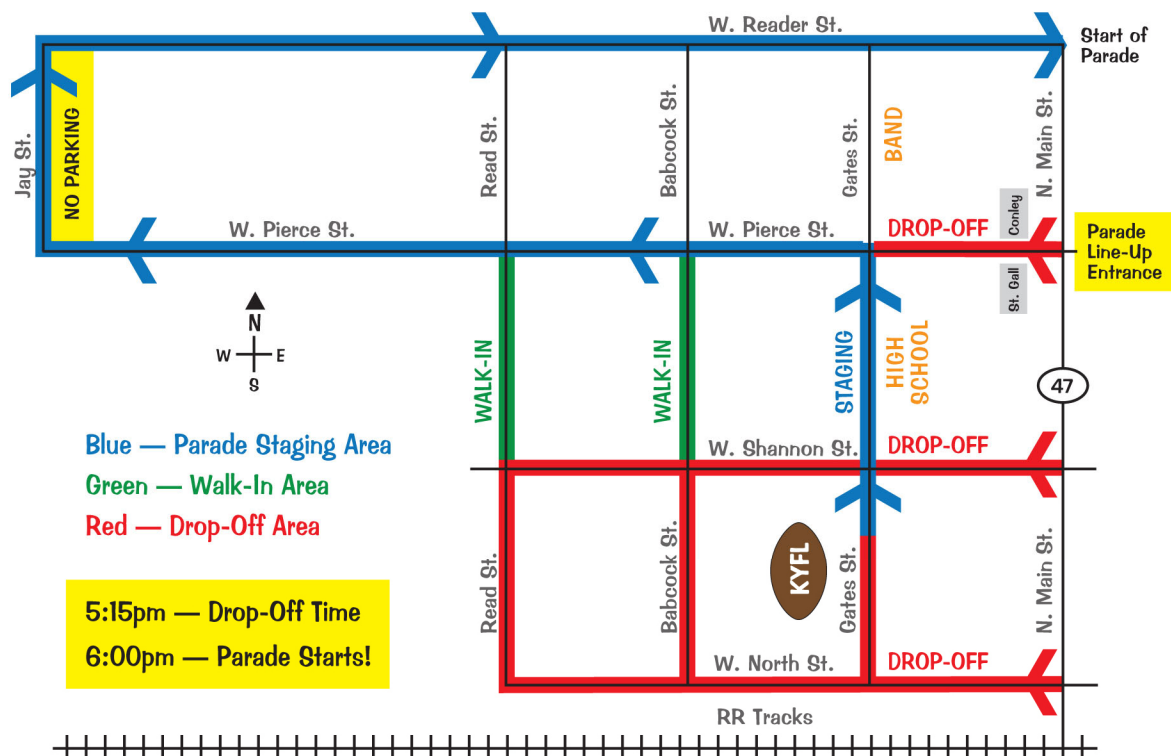

(d) each member of my organization ASSUMES FULL REponsibility FOR the risk of injury, damage, death, property damage, or other loss in any way connected with his or her participation or travel to or from the Parade, whether caused by any of the releasees' negligence or any other acts or omissions. This paragraph is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted under the Illinois Law and if any portion of this paragraph is held invalid, the balance of this paragraph and the agreement will continue in full force and effect.

(f) All candy/souvenirs NEEDS to be distributed by WALKERS: NOTHING TO BE THROWN from Vehicles/Floats/Trucks, etc.
